FYI Josephine Garis Cochrane of Shelbyville, Illinois was the inventor of the first practical dishwasher. According to the U.S. Patent and Trade Office, Cochrane received the patent for her invention in December of 1886. Seven years later, she displayed the dishwasher at the 1893 Chicago World's Fair. At that time, only the hospitality and restaurant industries showed interest. Dishwashers did not become a popular household appliance until the 1950s.
